1962 Studies in Rome, settles in Florence from 1963 to 1970.

1962–63 Studies at the Accademia di Belle Arti. Here contact with the Italian artist groups Numero and Strutture significanti and creation of first works in formally strictly structured colour elements.

1965 Co-founder of the Aquilone Gallery in Florence and editor of the magazine Comunicazione together with Claudio Popovich.

1965 In Zurich meeting with Max Bill.1st prize of the Premio Sinigallia organised by the Florentine KPI.

1966–68 Swiss Federal Art Scholarships1970 Moves to Milan. Friendship with the

artists Mario Nigro, Mario Ballocco, Gianni Colombo, Antonio Calderara.

1977 Through Richard Paul Lohse, he met the philosopher Hans Heinz Holz, who drew his attention to the social significance of constructive art.

1987 Exhibition at the Foundation for Concrete Art in Zurich as winner of the Camille Graeser Prize and in 1992 at the Josef Albers Museum in Bottrop.

1988 Move to Ameno at Lake Orta.

1990 Studio scholarship of the City of Zurich in New York, here contact with Leon Polk Smith.

 1998–14 Based in Paris, since then in Basel.
2016 Peter C. Ruppert Prize for Concrete Art.
